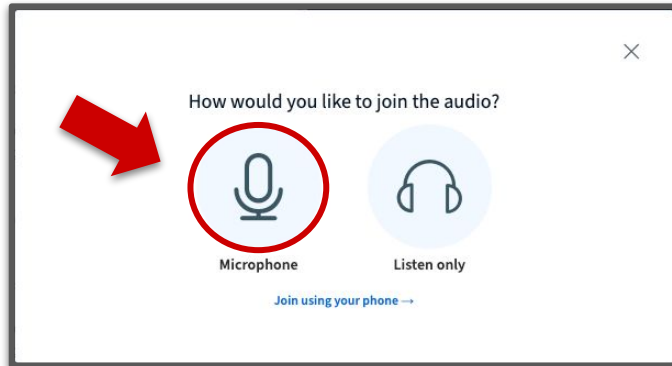

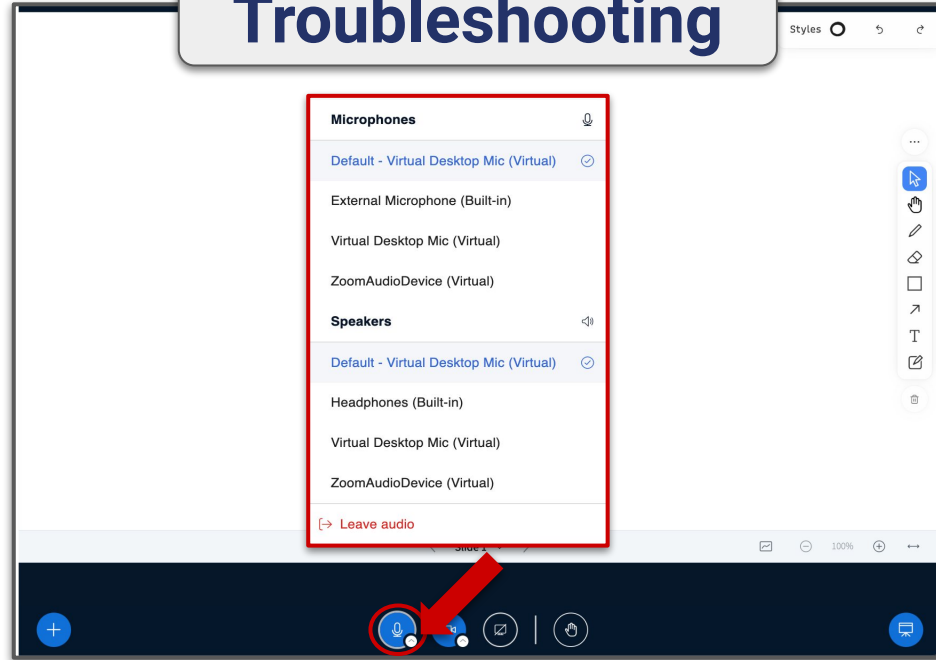

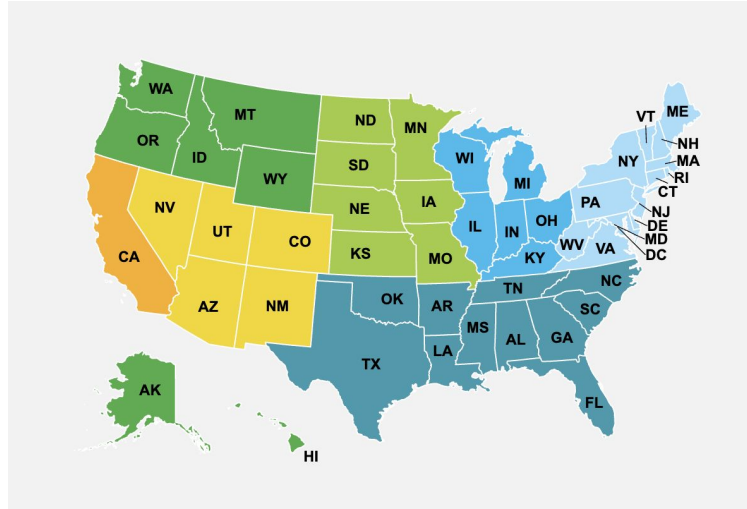

The implications are clear. Curriculum matters, but how teachers use curriculum matters even more.

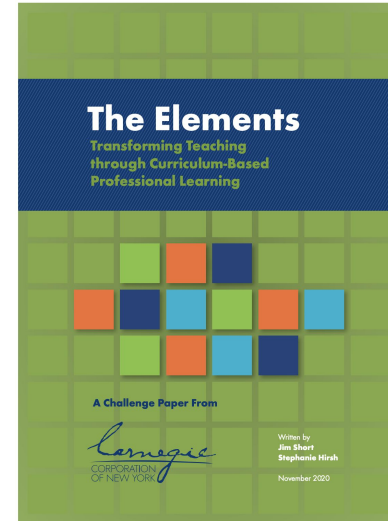

Curriculum-Based Professional Learning

It is rooted in **ongoing, active experiences** that prompt teachers to **change their instructional practices, expand their content knowledge, and challenge their beliefs.**

Task

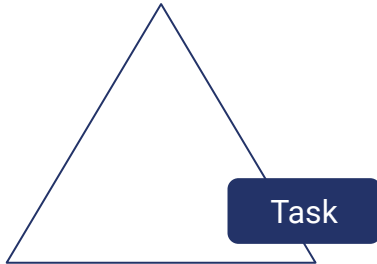
All students discuss a new problem or concept (explore).
